

Introduction

The Indian Industrial Hemp Association (IIHA) is a non-profit national organization, registered Under the Trust Act 1882, the Copyright Act 1999, with a motive to promote Indian ihemp and ihemp products globally. Established in 2011, the alliance represents those involved in India's iHemp industry, both nationally and globally. IIHA is the only association in the league to advocate Industrial Hemp cultivation; first to cultivate hemp legally after procuring relevant licenses post legalization in Uttarakhand.

IIHA have successfully completed 10yrs from the date of formation to 7yrs as registered under charitable Trust. The 1st IIHA board term ended in 2019 and new structure and organogram were purposed and were drafted by HYUSYS hired by IIHA looking at the new development around hemp industry in India . Due to COVID the new board and policy formation was delayed.

IIHA 1st Term goals were to get the Hemp Policy drafted and register the low THC varieties which was successfully achieved.

Within 7yrs IIHA spent 15 crores to achieve the target capital raised by Founder and Board of Trustees.

New Term (2021 to 2025)

The New Board Of Trustees and Managing committee will take the future board policy, budgets, agendas forward nationally and internationally.

Board

Board of Trustees will consist of Minimum 2 maximum 20 members paid members, Managing committee will consist of minimum 4 maximum 20 members paid and quota members and will be office bearers.

Reserved Quotas Seats : 2 Media, 2 Researchers, 2 Government Officials, *(These seats will be non-paid member seats selected by the Board of Trustees)*

Voting Rights

1. Board of Trustees : 20 Votes each
2. Managing committee : 10 Votes each
3. Corporate Member : 3 Votes each
4. Regular Member : 1 Vote each (New)

3. Opening Government recognised 1st Hemp Education University Degree and Diploma course.

New elected President of IIHA)

Board and Committee Selection Terms and Conditions

1. Should be Hemp Manufacturer Or Any other manufacturing unit which in line with Industry.
2. Should be having Hemp Cultivation licence.
3. NGOs (Operational in Hemp or Any other relevant industry)
4. Should be valid investor.
5. Should be minimum 3yrs in business/operational or having 2cr turnover for (Trader or Online Platform)

IIHA Invite and General Terms and Conditions for New Board (2022-2025)

Reserved Quota :

1. Should be from reputed media house sr. position.
2. Should have valid research background or associated with research institute.
3. Government official should be in the centre or state level secretariat.

Note : Similar qualification/status will be subjected to the market value, position, size, turnover and volume. Anyone who fits in other criteria/section/position may apply accordingly.

Timelines

1. Last Date of form Submission (30/Nov/2021) *(For Board members application only, regular member dates will be decided by the new board, All members who wish to participate on Board or Election may register.)*
2. New Board selection general meeting will be commenced after 10th December 2021. Invited Companies/Individual's will receive invite via mail. *(Location Delhi NCR this will be paid physical/in person meeting only in the special case of lockdown or such member who are non-resident of India they will be allowed to join online. This meeting will invite all interested members not limited to terms and condition and board will be selected after the general meeting.)*
3. Final board will be formed before 31st December.
4. New Election of different posts will be held from 10th January but not later than 30th January.
5. The formal handovers and KRAs and agreements will be commenced before 15th Feb. but not later than 31st March.
